Just for the record, things are not done down here with the precision we might expect in the United States but the Lord, as always, carried us through. During some tough times in the final weeks before the crusade, the Lord reassured Richard's heart "I am in this. It will not flounder," and to my heart, "My glory will descend." A present personal word from the Lord is like a life line in the storms of life and as we hung on in total dependence on the Lord, He amazingly worked all things together for a glorious success!

By the time of the last volunteer training—the weekend before the event—we had just over

700 volunteers working on eleven committees.

That was a huge number for the size of our area, but the Body of Christ came together with great joy and heart-felt enthusiasm for the work of the Lord. The Mayor (president) of Los Cabos, Arturo de la Rosa, actually provided many of the items and services we needed for the campaign site. God used him and the Municipality of Los Cabos in many ways that got us to the finish line. This precious, honorable man had planned on coming to the crusade on Tuesday night but instead had to be in Mexico City. He sent his wife in his place, who spoke encouragingly to the crowd of over 3,000. She received the bible the area pastors bought Mayor Arturo, her bouquet of flowers, and stood in the gap for her husband, as the pastors and believers in the crowd stretched their hands toward her in prayer. The favor of God shown by Mayor Arturo alone is reason to rejoice!



When the crusade first began... The air was full of excitement on Monday the 18th of April as the praise music started to fill the air. The weather was beautiful for all three days as we worshiped the Lord overlooking famous Medano Beach and the Sea of Cortez. The setting was perfect for the celebration of the King of Kings. We had an estimated 2,000 plus people on Monday night with approximately 400 coming forward to accept the Lord or for recommitment. There were roughly 3,200 plus on Tuesday, with as many as Monday coming forward. Then on Wednesday, we could feel we had broken through the spiritual opposition of the area. Over 4,000 people came and many stood on the sides of the chairs, next to the lines of security volunteers, riveted with Carlos Annacondia's message of their need to forgive everyone in their lives whom they had offence against. The huge altar area didn't 'fill up' that night, it was just instantly full and the presence of the Lord was heavy. Even the altar ministry was different that night, with the deliverance tent being filled with people in need of ministry and more people than the first two nights testifying of significant healings in their bodies.





I can't possibly begin to share the testimonies of the people who were physically touched by the power of God. The line of people waiting to give testimony was estimated at twenty people on the first night and increased from there. On the second night, a man who was told that he would never walk by his doctor—and if he did, would die immediately from a heart attack—got out of his wheelchair, dancing and praising the Lord. He eventually lost his balance and fell that night, but after prayer in the deliverance tent and practice walking, he was walking upright the next night; up on stage, with no problems with his heart.

On one of the first two nights, a young girl's eyes were healed and she no longer had to wear glasses to see. The next morning, her teacher asked her why she did not have her glasses on, and the girl proudly told her she had been prayed for at the crusade the night before and no longer needed glasses. The teacher brought her to the front of the class so she could testify to her fellow students as to what had happened—just imagine the great joy!

On the last night, a teenage boy who was completely deaf received his healing. He testified from the stage—with the high pitched, faltering voice of one who had never learned to speak because of his deafness—giving glory to God for his hearing. What a life changing experience this was for him!

These are just a handful of the miracles God performed during only three days. The raw video footage of the crusade is currently being edited into an hour-long video presentation. As the hosts for the Annacondia team, Richard and I were honored to talk with Carlos Annacondia, feel the preciousness of his character, ask questions through the interpreter, and glean wisdom from him. Richard and I read his books, as well as the books recommended by Carlos, in preparation for the crusade. We knew he had had crusades that changed cities and entire regions in Argentina, so we asked him about these former crusades. The key to such change from a crusade, as opposed to the continued working for the transformation of an area, was the time frame of the crusades, as experienced in the early years of working the soil of Argentina. Several of these crusades were as

long as forty to fifty days.

In summation of this grand crusade in Los Cabos; from the very beginning and still to this day, the Lord impressed upon our hearts that we needed to invite Carlos Annacondia because he is known as one of God's generals who breaks through the darkness in the spiritual climate of an area. In fact, many of the reports use the phrase, "before Annacondia" and "after Annacondia." We believe this happened on the second day of the crusade, Tuesday, April 19th. The purpose of bringing Carlos Annacondia to Los Cabos has been accomplished—only by the grace of God, and we give all glory to Him for the breakthrough. In reality, our financial resources were depleted with only three days of crusade and our few, faithful leaders in the Mexican churches were worn, as well.



For these reasons, we rejoice in what the Lord has done! We look forward with great expectation to the days ahead, as we continue with many plans for the transformation of Los Cabos. We are standing on the promises of the Lord and we speak of His intentions and His purposes for an area of Mexico that for years has been known for just about everything, but godliness. What a mighty God we serve!
