The Greatest Days of Our Lives Lie Ahead of Us

If parts of this article seem similar to former newsletter articles, I want you to know that it is the Lord Who is repeating Himself. "Parallelism" is a writing technique of repeating important phrases and verses for emphasis. It was used in several places in the Bible and is an example of how the Lord uses repetition to get our attention. Similarly, it is often said that God gives information on a need-to-know basis, so when He continues to repeat Himself, it is because we may have acknowledged the information in our heads but still do not have the 'download' in our spirit.

Recently, the Lord again impressed upon my heart that we are entering a 'new era;' the old has gone and the 'new' has come. Definitions from Oxford Languages defines an "era" as "a long and distinct period of history with a particular feature or characteristic," In the days and years ahead of us, we can expect the Lord to "show off" His power and might as a means of drawing the nations to His Son; "For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, As the waters cover the sea" (Habakkuk 2:14).


As a result of this "eternal weight of glory" (II Corinthians 4:17), we can expect the "period of history" that lies before us to be filled with noteworthy events; such as signs and wonders coming sovereignly from the Lord, as well as those resulting from specific prayers and the declarations of His people. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." (Luke 4:18-19, NKJV)

The manifestations of the Holy Spirt that are listed in these two verses should be evident in Jesus' Body, which is made up of all true believers in Christ. We should expect to see and experience more of these ministry opportunities in the days and years ahead, as well as greater and more powerful answers to our prayers and ministry to others.

"For the eyes of the LORD move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His" (II Chronicles 16:9a).

God has a special purpose for every one of His children. He certainly has a higher calling for each one of us than just existing until death, or until Christ's return! A.B. Simpson, founder of The Christian and Missionary Alliance, penned it this way, "All the experiences of life come to us as tests, and as we meet them our loving Father is watching with intense and jealous love to see us overcome. If we fail He is deeply disappointed, and our adversary is filled with joy. We are being watched continually by angels and principalities, and every step we take is critical and decisive for something in our eternal future."²

What your eyes behold and what your ears hear will fill your soul (your mind, will and emotions), and what you are full of will come forth in your life.

Our Heavenly Father doesn't just desire for us to overcome. He needs us to overcome. Jesus, our head, is in the heavenlies, but He has need of a Body on earth who feels His heart and is led by His eyes. "He is representing us in heaven, and our business is to represent Him on earth."

The secret to overcoming is our perspective, and our perspective depends on where our eyes are focused and what voices we are listening to. What your eyes behold and what your ears hear will fill your soul (your

mind, will and emotions), and what you are full of will come forth in your life.

What Choice Will You Make?

The Lord really is looking throughout the earth—in every nation—trying to find those whose heart is really His; and He will, absolutely "strongly support" each one that He finds. Our First Post Covid-19 Neighborhood Crusade!

Near the end of March, the Cristo es el Camino Church finally received authorization to hold a two-day event in the Colonia (neighborhood) of Las Palmas! For those of you who follow our newsletters and blogs, you might remember the name of this neighborhood from several years

> ago. Pastor Carlos Maciel and his magnificent team of workers started a Bible study in the home of one of their attendees who lived in Las Palmas. From that Bible study, the church branched out to having services in a 'relatively' empty lot not too far from the home where the Bible study was. Our ministry paid the rent up front for several months for this church start. However, when the owner found out that Pastor Carlos had 'Gringo' money behind him, the rent was tripled.

At the same time, the satanic influence in the area was at work, resulting in the enemy gaining a foothold in one of the family members of one of the first families committed to the church plant. As we prayer walked the area, we were told by other Christians about the heavy presence of practicing witches in the area; and one day Pastor Carlos and I had a significant encounter. One of the area witches, who we had identified and seen several times as we prayer walked, confronted the two of us. She glared with her dark eyes at Pastor Carlos and me and snarled, "Many (in reference to Christians trying to make an influence) come, but they all go." Shortly after that is when the foundation of the work started to crumble.

A handful of times, throughout the passing years, I have brought up the words of that witch to Pastor Carlos. He remembered that day as well, and was also grieved by her scorn, but at the end of March, Pastor Carlos planned his first Post-Covid-19 crusade in Las Palmas. Since governmental Covid-19 restrictions had just been lifted, only a handful of flyers (relative to their usual canvassing) was handed out for this two day event. It started on Saturday evening, continuing with a free breakfast for the neighborhood on Sunday morning, and then Sunday evening was the closing service for this outreach.

This event was a glorious reunion for this congregation! The Cristo es el Camino Church family

Festiniños, La Gran Aventura Our Samaritan's Purse Annual Celebration!

For those of you who faithfully follow our blogs and quarterly newsletters, you are now very familiar with Cristo es el Camino's annual celebration of "Festiniños, La Gran Aventura." We have been honored to sponsor the Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child 'shoe boxes' since 2014. If you are not familiar with this fabulous ministry outreach, please check out the previous blogs on our website where we have shared extensive information about Operation Christmas Child; including last year's June 1 blog.

This year, I am going to report on this valuable annual program a little differently—with a picture presentation. Due to the final Covid-19 restrictions, this year's celebrations were held at four different Christo es el Camino churches/missions. For those of you who follow our ministry in Los Cabos, you will certainly recognize these locations.

Tierra y Libertad Church

This church is in the colonia of Tierra y Libertad and for some time has been used as the "Mother Church" for Pastor Carlos Maciel's flock. We originally purchased the "right to squat" on the two lots this church has been progressively built on.

Lomas del Sol Church

This smaller church is where we started in 2011. This was our first building project for Cristo es el Camino Church.

Valle del Cabo Church

This is the second major building project for the Cristo es el Camino church family. From its humble beginnings, this church has also been a work-in-progress.

Caribe Mission

This location is a small building next to the leader's home, and has been used more like what we would think of in the United States as a home group. This location is currently under reconstruction.

I hope you enjoyed this year's reporting of the graduation party known as Festiniños, La Gran Aventura. As always, we covet your continual prayers over what God is doing in Los Cabos, Mexico. We have only been able to minister here these last eleven years because of each one of you. May the Lord bless you and keep you!
